Eight weeks of internship will be in semester IV. One week for Annual Lesson will be utilized in this semester. The remaining seven weeks will be utilised for school internship and Activities as usual.

100 marks have been allotted to this seven week work. 65 marks will be for Internship. Out of which 30 is for internal and 35 is for external assessment. 35 marks are allotted for activities. Out of which 20 will be for internal and 15 will be for external assessment.

Out of 34 Lessons four will be examined externally. The remaining 30 lessons will be examined internally (28 lesson by school teacher + 2 lesson by concern training college teacher) (Marking scheme is shown in Table -12-13)

The work of Trainees during seven weeks in school inclues activities also. The list of activities is mentioned in the separate Internship booklet. Total 35 marks have been allocated

to activities. Out of which 20 is for internal & 15 is for external assessment. Action Research (15 marks) will be examined externally. The remaining four activities (20 marks) will be examined internally.
